Dr. Stephen Loyd currently serves as Medical Director of JourneyPure's services in Middle Tennessee, including four outpatient clinics and its residential facility JourneyPure At The River. His extensive background includes serving as Medical Director and Assistant Commissioner for Substance Abuse Services with the Tennessee Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services. Dr. Loyd was appointed to Tennessee Governor Bill Haslam's Opioid Workgroup and Public Safety Sub-cabinet. He is currently serving on the Tennessee Board of Medical Examiners. Dr. Loyd has been in long-term recovery from opioids and benzodiazepines since July 9, 2004.



Dr. Brian Fingerson is the President of KYPRN, a company formed to educate health care professionals about the disease of chemical dependency, and to monitor the recovery of Kentucky licensed professionals with addictions. KYPRN administers the recovery programs for eleven licensing Boards in Kentucky. He has worked in this field since 1986. He is Adjunct Assistant Professor at the University of Kentucky Colleges of Pharmacy, Sullivan University College of Pharmacy, Assistant Professor (voluntary faculty) Department of Oral Health Sciences, and University of Kentucky College of Dentistry.



Dr. Clark Gaither, a family physician, is currently the Medical Director of the North Carolina Professionals Health Program and a Fellow of the American Academy of Family Physicians. Also known as Dr. Burnout, he is an expert in the identification, mitigation, and prevention of physician job-related burnout. He is the author of REIGNITE, a best-selling book about professional job-related burnout. A recipient of many rewards, Dr. Gaither was named Family Physician of the Year in 2002 by the NC Academy of Family Physicians.



Dr. Dale Kennedy is a 1978 graduate of UT Memphis School of Dentistry and a member of the PSI Chapter of OKU. Dr. Kennedy maintains a private practice in Athens, Tennessee. He is current President of the Tennessee Dental Wellness Foundation. Dr. Kennedy is a member of ADA, TDA, AGD, Fellow in the American College of Dentists, Past-President of the American Academy of Dental Practice and a Past-President of the East Tennessee Academy of Dental Practice Administration.



Dr. Brent Boyett was trained as a general dentist and is board certified in Family Medicine as a physician. He practiced both dentistry and primary care medicine until he discovered his passion in the field of addiction medicine in 2008. He became board certified in Addiction Medicine and has distinguished himself as a speaker, researcher and thought leader in the field of addiction medicine. Recognizing the extreme unmet need for access to outpatient addiction treatment, Dr. Boyett established Pathway Partners Addiction Medicine, now known as Pathway Healthcare, an evidence-based model for outpatient treatment of addictive disorders. Dr. Boyett is now the former CMO of Pathway Healthcare. Dr. Boyett continues to practice clinical addiction medicine as the CMO of Bradford Health Services at the Madison, Alabama location.
