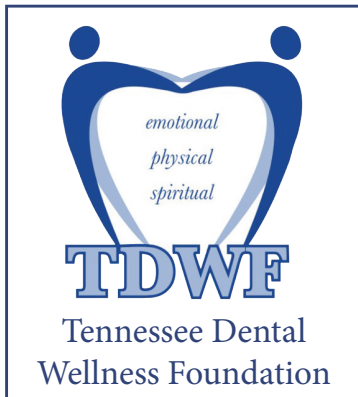

David E. Tiner, D.D.S., L.M.F.T. after nearly twenty years of practicing dentistry, a personal crisis led Dr. Tiner to embark on a new journey. His desire to understand how things worked expanded to include the realm of the emotions, the realm of the heart. He spent the next twenty years working with individuals and couples struggling with addiction, life trauma, or marriage and family problems. David served three years active duty in the U.S. Navy and seven years in the U.S. Naval Active Reserves as a dental officer. Currently he is the Executive Director of the TDWF.



Phil Herndon, MA, LPC-MHSP, NCC, uses a dynamic approach to help his clients recover their hearts and redeem their stories. Phil works with individuals who have lost their way through addiction, anxiety, depression, struggles with spirituality, or burnout to walk them through the tumultuous and scary times that are so common to the human experience. He completed graduate school in 1992 with a Master of Arts degree in counseling and religious education. Phil is the Clinical Director and co-owner of River Tree. Phil lives in Murfreesboro with his wife, Sheila, and they have one son, Luke.



Stephen Loyd, M.D. an Internal Medicine/Addiction Medicine physician. He currently serves as the VP of the Tennessee Board of Medical Examiners. Dr. Loyd was the Assistant Commissioner (Opioid Czar) for Substance Abuse Services in the Tennessee Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services in Governor Bill Haslam's Administration. He was an original member (still active) of the Treatment of Chronic Pain Guidelines Committee which defined pain treatment for providers in the state of Tennessee. Dr. Loyd was the inspiration behind Michael Keaton's character in the Hulu Emmy Award winning series "Dopesick". He also serves as the Chief Medical Officer for Cedar Recovery and is the current Chair of the Tennessee Opioid Abatement Council appointed by Governor Bill Lee. Dr. Loyd has been in recovery from opioid and benzodiazepine addiction since July 8, 2004.



Chip Dodd, PhD, is a mentor, consultant, author, and counselor who has been working in the field of relationship and recovery for over 30 years. He received his PhD in counseling from the University of North Texas in 1990. Soon after, he developed the Spiritual Root System. In 1996, Dr. Dodd founded a Nashville based treatment center, which he led for more than 20 years. Since 2019, he has been fully devoted to mentoring, consulting, and counseling. Dr. Dodd is the author of eight books, including The Voice of the Heart, The Perfect Loss, and How Are You Feeling Today? Chip and his wife, Sonya, have been married for nearly 40 years and they have two grown sons.
